



Union Home and Cooperation Minister Amit Shah launched Agriculture 2 (AGR-2), a central scheme with 50% subsidy to farmers on the purchase of nano-fertilizers. Amit Shah gave subsidy to three farmers under this scheme. The government has launched a 100-day action plan to promote nano-

The Asian Development Bank (ADB) and Engie Group have signed a long-term local currency loan agreement to build and operate a 400 megawatt solar photovoltaic power plant in the Surendranagar district of Gujarat, India. ADB was named as the lead arranger for the entire loan of 14.6 billion Indian rupees (about \$175.9 million), with ADB and the Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank providing 7.3 billion Indian rupees. The project will support the Indian government's goal of achieving at least 500 gigawatts of non-fossil fuel energy capacity by 2030.

The Krishnaraja Sagar (KRS) reservoir on the Cauvery river recently crossed the 100 feet mark, reaching a maximum level of 124.80 feet. Located in Mandya, Karnataka, the gravity dam was constructed between 1911 and 1931. Named after Maharaja Krishnaraja Wadiyar IV and designed by Sir M. Visvesvaraya, the dam's main purpose is irrigation, hydropower and drought mitigation. The reservoir is spread over 130 square kilometres.
