He also formally launched the Fauna Portal of India operated by the Zoological Survey of India. It includes a list of the entire known fauna of India. It includes 104,561 faunal species. The minister also inaugurated the 2nd Fauna Taxonomy Summit-2024 organized by the Zoological Survey of India in Kolkata.
