

Toy Bizz International 2024 is scheduled to be held on 06-09 July 2024 at Pragati Maidan New Delhi, India. Toy Bizz International 2024 is a trade fair for the childcare and toy industries in India. It is giving businesses the opportunity to acquire new toys, learn about the latest trends in the toy industry, and network with other industry professionals. Around 500 exhibitors are expected to participate in this expo and they will also showcase a wide range of toys including building blocks, educational toys, outdoor toys, dolls.

Space Exploration and Research Agency (SERA) and Blue Origin have declared India as a partner nation for their manned space flight programme. The programme is for citizens of countries that have sent few or no astronauts to space. US-based agency SERA will offer six seats to citizens from around the world on future missions of Blue Origin's reusable suborbital rocket New Shepard. New Shepard will send selected astronauts for 11 minutes beyond the Kármán line (about 100 km above the Earth's surface), which is internationally recognised as the boundary of space. The astronauts will experience a state of weightlessness in the absence of gravity for several minutes before landing on the ground.

4. B

Ravindra Kumar Tyagi has been appointed as the new Chairman and Managing Director (CMD) of Power Grid Corporation of India Limited (PGCIL). He will replace K Srikanth, who took over from him. Tyagi's appointment was approved by the Appointments Committee of the Cabinet (ACC) on 18 December 2023. Prior to this, he was serving as the Director of Operations in Power Grid of India since August 2022.

A team of researchers from the Zoological Survey of India (ZSI) has recorded a new species of forest-dwelling horned frog in Arunachal Pradesh. The bird, new to science, Xenophrys apatani, recovered from Tale Wildlife Sanctuary in Lower Subansiri district, has been named after the

The 16th edition of the joint military exercise 'Nomadic Elephant' between the Indian Army and the Mongolian Army began in Umroi, Meghalaya on July 2024. The aim of this military exercise is to enhance military interoperability between the two countries. The two-week-long exercise will end on July 16.

The All India Football Federation mourns the death of former Indian winger Bhupendra Singh Rawat, who passed away in Surat, Gujarat after a prolonged illness. He was 85. A pacey winger of the 1960s and 1970s, Rawat played for India in the Merdeka Tournament in Malaysia in 1969. In domestic football, he played for top teams like Delhi Garrison, Gorkha Brigade and Mafatlal. He represented Services and Maharashtra in the National Football Championship for the Santosh Trophy. Rawat was a fans' favourite due to his agility and ability to penetrate the opponent's defence despite his small stature, which earned him the nickname 'Scooter'.

8. D

Former world chess champion Viswanathan Anand of India has won the Leon Master Chess Championship for the 10th time. He won the 2024 Leon Masters title by defeating Jaime Santos Llatasa of Spain 3-1 in the final played in Leon, Spain. Five-time world champion Viswanathan Anand has previously won the Leon Masters in 1996, 1999, 2000, 2001, 2005, 2006, 2007, 2011, 2016 and 2024.

9. B

Air India is setting up South Asia's largest flight training school in Maharashtra's Amravati district by investing over Rs 200 crore. The school is scheduled to open in the first quarter of the next financial year. The initiative is aimed at securing a steady pipeline of pilots for the airline, which

ICICI Bank has launched the Saphiro Forex Card designed for students going abroad for higher education. Powered by Visa, the card offers customized benefits for managing education expenses such as admission fees, course-related costs and daily expenses such as travel and meals. It supports transactions in 15 currencies without cross-currency mark-up charges, facilitating seamless global travel.

Senior Sri Lankan politician and moderate Tamil leader R Sampanthan has died while undergoing treatment in hospital, the Tamil National Alliance has announced. Sampanthan, 91, led the Tamil National Alliance (TNA) since 2004 and was the second Tamil to become the main opposition leader in the Sinhalese-dominated country.

12. C

NASA's Mars Odyssey orbiter captured a stunning view of Olympus Mons, the solar system's largest volcano. Launched in 2001, Odyssey's mission includes mapping the surface of Mars and serving as a communications relay. Olympus Mons, a shield volcano, is 24 kilometers high and 550 kilometers wide, dwarfing Earth's Mauna Loa. Odyssey holds the record for the longest active mission around another planet, scheduled to last until 2025.

13. C

Christina Ernst, a software engineer at Google, has created a stir on social media by creating the "world's first AI dress". Christina, who is also the founder of the website shebuildsrobots.org, shared a short video of her "robotic Medusa dress" on Instagram, which has been viewed more than 3 million times so far.

The World Bank has approved \$1.5 billion to support India's low-carbon energy development. The funding will promote green hydrogen, electrolysers, and renewable energy. This is in line with India's national Green Hydrogen Mission and energy goals: 500 gigawatts of renewable energy capacity by 2030 and achieving net zero emissions by 2070.
