#### ➤ Aero India 2025: India's Aerospace Innovations and Global Ties

Aero India 2025, Asia's premier aerospace exhibition, is set to take place from February 10 to 14, 2025, at Air Force Station, Yelahanka, Bengaluru. Under the theme "The Runway to a Billion Opportunities," the event aims to bolster India's position in the global aerospace sector and foster international partnerships.



#### ➤ Amit Shah to Launch CBI's BHARATPOL Portal

Union Home Minister and Minister of Cooperation, Shri Amit Shah, will launch the BHARATPOL portal developed by the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) on January, 2025, at Bharat Mandapam, New Delhi. The portal aims to facilitate real-time international police assistance and enhance India's efforts to combat transnational crimes. Developed by the CBI, which acts as the National Central Bureau (NCB) for INTERPOL in India, the portal will improve communication between law enforcement agencies (LEAs) across India and INTERPOL.



#### ➤ Jammu Becomes Indian Railways' 69th Division

On January, 2025, Prime Minister Narendra Modi virtually inaugurated the Jammu Railway Division, marking it as the 69th division under the Northern Railway Zone. This strategic move aims to enhance connectivity and foster socio-economic development in the northernmost regions of India.

#### ➤ **India's Metro Rail Network Surpasses 1,000 km, Becoming World's Third Largest**

As of January 2025, India has achieved a significant milestone by expanding its metro rail network to over 1,000 kilometers of operational lines, positioning it as the third-largest in the world, following China and the United States.



#### ➤ **Centre Launches India's First Organic Fisheries Cluster in Sikkim**

Union Animal Husbandry and Fisheries Minister Rajiv Ranjan Singh launched the country's first-ever organic fisheries cluster in Soreng District, Sikkim. This initiative aims to revolutionize the aquaculture industry by promoting ecologically sustainable and chemical-free fish farming practices. The cluster will focus on providing organic, antibiotic-free, and pesticide-free fish, catering to eco-conscious markets globally. This development aligns with Sikkim's reputation for sustainable agricultural practices, as the state has already embraced organic farming.



#### ➤ **Tamil Nadu CM Announces \$1 Million Prize for Deciphering Indus Valley Script**

In a significant announcement marking the centenary of the discovery of the Indus Valley Civilisation, Tamil Nadu Chief Minister M K Stalin has pledged a \$1 million prize for experts or organizations that succeed in deciphering the mysterious Indus Valley script.



Speaking at a three-day International Conference in Chennai, the Chief Minister highlighted the importance of unraveling this ancient script and reaffirmed Tamil Nadu's commitment to supporting research and archaeological endeavors.

#### ➤ Odisha Government's ₹15 Crore Sponsorship Elevates Indian Kho Kho

The Odisha government has announced a significant three-year sponsorship deal worth ₹15 crore for the Indian national kho kho team, aiming to enhance the sport's prominence both nationally and internationally. Chief Minister Mohan Charan Majhi revealed that the state will invest ₹5 crore annually from January 2025 to December 2027, with funding provided through the Odisha Mining Corporation.
