Answer Key & Explanation

1. A

The Employees' Provident Fund Organisation (EPFO) has fully implemented the Centralised Pension Payment System (CPPS). The CPPS allows 7.85 million pensioners to receive their pension from any bank or branch across the country. It eliminates physical verification and ensures seamless pension disbursement. The new system replaces the decentralised model, which relied on limited agreements with specific banks. Pensioners no longer need to transfer pension payment orders (PPOs) when changing banks or relocating. The pension amount is credited immediately upon release, adding convenience and ease of living.

2. B

NTT DoCoMo, Japan's largest mobile service provider, said it was working to restore services after a cyberattack temporarily disrupted operations. The Tokyo-based company said in a

statement that its systems were targeted by a distributed denial-of-service (DDoS) attack, which floods the network with junk traffic from multiple sources, making some services unavailable.

3. D

Former Union Home Secretary Ajay Kumar Bhalla took oath as the 19th Governor of Manipur. The swearing-in ceremony was held at Raj Bhavan in Imphal. Manipur Chief Minister N Biren Singh, his council of ministers and high-ranking government and police officials attended the ceremony. Speaking after the swearing-in ceremony, Manipur CM Biren Singh said that by appointing Balla as the Governor, the Centre has shown its intent to resolve issues in Manipur.

4. B

The National Investigation Agency (NIA) has achieved 100 per cent conviction rate in 2024. This includes conviction of 68 accused in 25 cases decided by special NIA courts across the country. A total of 210 accused were arrested by the NIA in 2024 in 80 cases registered under major categories of crime - Left Wing Extremism, Northeast Insurgency, Khalistani terrorism, gangster-terrorist-smuggler nexus, etc.

5. B

The Mahabharat Vatika, developed by the Uttarakhand Forest Department in Haldwani, houses 37 plant species mentioned in the epic. It is spread over one acre and aims to highlight ecological knowledge from the Mahabharat, particularly emphasising the interdependence of nature and wildlife. The garden underlines the importance of forests mentioned in the epic and serves as a bridge between historical, cultural and environmental conservation efforts.

6. A

French-Indian Sanskrit scholar and Padma Shri awardee Dr Pierre-Sylvain Filliozat (89) died after a brief illness in Paris. Dr Pierre-Sylvain Filliozat was admitted to a private hospital in the city last week and was airlifted to Paris for advanced treatment, where he passed away, sources said.

The Uttar Pradesh government has made major changes at the governance level. In this, the work area of 46 IAS officers has been changed. After this change, changes have also been seen in the work area of many Principal Secretaries. These changes are expected to infuse new energy in the administrative structure of the state. Under this change, the UP government has entrusted an important responsibility to Sanjay Prasad. Prasad has been appointed to the post of Principal Secretary Home. He is currently working as Principal Secretary in the Chief Minister's Office. Now he will also take charge of the Home Department.

8. D

India submitted its fourth biennial update report to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change. According to the report, India's greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions decreased by 7.93 percent in 2020 compared to 2019. Union Minister for Forest, Environment and Climate Change Bhupendra Yadav shared this information in Xpost. Yadav said that India is setting an example in sustainable development. These achievements reflect Prime Minister Narendra Modi's commitment to combine economic progress with meaningful climate action.

9. C

Tripura recorded the Banded Royal butterfly (*Rachna jalindra indra*) for the first time in Sipahijala Wildlife Sanctuary. It is a lycaenid butterfly found in South and South-East Asia, including forests of Northeast India. Three subspecies are found in India: *macantia* (south-west India to Goa), *tarpeena* (Andamans), and *indra* (Orissa to West Bengal, Assam, Meghalaya, Jharkhand). The male has a deep purple sheen; the female is brown with white markings. The underside of the wings is light brown with white streaks, giving it a "banded" look.

10. A

India has completed the 9.214 km long border fencing project at Moreh in Manipur along the Indo-Myanmar border and the construction of a road parallel to the fence is in progress. A Home Ministry report said the project aims to enhance security and curb illegal cross-border activities, as well as improve access to the area and strengthen patrolling.

Famous Bengali director Arun Roy died at the age of 56 due to severe lung infection. Roy was battling cancer for a year. RG Kar Medical College and Hospital, Kolkata confirmed his death. Arun Roy is known for his excellent direction in Bengali cinema. He made a big mark through his first film 'Hiralal', in which Kinjal Nanda was seen in an important role. After the success of this film, Arun achieved a special position in the world of cinema. Arun Roy got a lot of fame from his first film Hiralal. Apart from this, in the year 2023, the film 'Bagha Jatin' was made based on the life of revolutionary Jatindranath Mukherjee, whose character was played by Dev. The film was highly appreciated by critics and audiences.

Scientists at the Coimbatore-based Sugarcane Breeding Institute have prepared sugarcane juice powder, making it possible to enjoy sugarcane juice in every season. Scientists claim that this sugarcane juice powder will be rich in nutrients. The sugarcane juice powder will be packed and its validity will be six months from the manufacturing date. This juice powder will not only be natural but will also be available in lemon flavor. Fresh sugarcane juice can be prepared by mixing it in 200 ml of water.

The first coastal and wader bird census will be held in Gujarat's Marine National Park and Sanctuary, covering 170 km of coastline from Okha to Navlakhi. The three-day event will include expert talks, bird count activities and knowledge-sharing sessions, involving bird enthusiasts, experts and researchers from across the country.

Senior officials visited to inspect the unit at Pithampur in Madhya Pradesh's Dhar district, where 337 tonnes of toxic waste linked to the Bhopal gas tragedy is to be incinerated, after rumours spread on social media that one of the containers carrying the waste had gone missing. Sub divisional magistrate (SDM) Pramod Singh Gurjar said information was being spread through

The Finance Ministry has imposed a definitive anti-dumping duty for a period of five years on Digital Offset Printing Plates (DOPP) - commonly known as digital plates - originating from China, South Korea, Japan, Taiwan and Vietnam. Based on the recommendations made by the Directorate General of Trade Remedies (DGTR) in its final findings on the sunset review petition, the revenue department has now imposed a definitive anti-dumping duty that ranges from \$0.13/SQM to 0.77/SQM depending on the country of origin and export.
