Sheikh Hasina's niece, Britain's Finance Minister Tulip Siddiqui, has suffered a major setback. She has resigned from the post of Britain's Finance Minister. Labour Party MP Emma Reynolds has been appointed as the new Finance Minister in her place. On the other hand, Bangladesh interim government head Muhammad Yunus has demanded the British government to investigate Tulip Siddiqui's properties. He has also alleged that Tulip Siddiqui may have properties from the alleged scam committed by ousted Sheikh Hasina in Bangladesh.

"Ek Thali, Ek Bag" campaign launched to promote plastic-free event at Maha Kumbh in Prayagraj. Cloth bags and steel plates and glasses are being distributed in place of plastic and disposable items. So far, around 70,000 cloth bags have been distributed from six centres. More than 20 lakh steel plates and glasses collected from across the country are being made available to langars and eateries. Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath urged pilgrims to adopt eco-friendly methods and avoid single-use plastic during the yatra.

India has made significant progress in next-generation telecommunications technology. In this direction, the Centre for Development of Telematics (C-DOT) and the Indian Institute of Technology, Bombay (IIT Bombay) have signed an agreement to develop "Optical Transceiver Chipsets for High-Bandwidth 6G Wireless Links". The initiative falls under the 6G proposal call under the Telecom Technology Development Fund (TTDF) of the Department of Telecommunications (DoT). It aims to prepare India for global leadership in 6G innovation and implementation by 2030, with a focus on affordable, sustainable and pervasive technology.

6. C

The Trajan 155 mm towed artillery gun system developed by India and France has received an export order from Armenia. It is a 155 mm, 52-calibre towed gun system, jointly developed by Larsen & Toubro (L&T) and KNDS France and manufactured in India. The gun has a range of over 40 km, depending on the ammunition, and is designed for modern warfare. It features

advanced targeting, fire-control systems, modular design for easy transportation, fast firing rate and terrain adaptability.

Senior Indian Administrative Service (IAS) officer Vineet Joshi took charge as Secretary, Department of Higher Education at Shastri Bhawan in New Delhi. The Education Ministry said that after taking charge, Joshi interacted with senior officials of the ministry. Joshi, a 1992 batch IAS officer of Manipur cadre, has previously held several important positions in the education sector. Prior to this appointment, Joshi was working as the Chief Secretary of Manipur. He has held several important positions in the education sector, including Director General of the National Examination Agency (NTA), Chairman of the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) and Additional Secretary in the Ministry of Education.

Celebrated Hollywood director and writer David Lynch has died at the age of 78. A true visionary of modern cinema, Lynch revolutionised the film industry with his distinctive surrealist style and exploration of the dark aspects of human nature and the subconscious. His work, which often delved into bizarre and disturbing plots, left an indelible mark on both the horror and psychological thriller genres. Lynch's creative genius spanned six decades and earned him numerous accolades, including four Academy Award nominations and a Palme d'Or. Best known for creating the iconic TV series Twin Peaks, Lynch's contribution to cinema is admired worldwide.

The Union Ministry of Culture and the Government of Gujarat inaugurated a state-of-the-art museum and archaeological interpretation centre in Vadnagar. The 2,500-year-old city of Vadnagar was the centre of ancient trade routes, with rich heritage such as the Kirti Toran, Hatkeshwar Mahadev Temple and Sharmishtha Lake. The museum complex is spread over 12,500

sq m, with nine galleries, a 4,000 sq m excavation site and 5,000 artefacts. The ₹298 crore project integrates sustainability and includes a five-year operation and maintenance.

Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi inaugurated the 'Bharat Mobility Global Expo 2025' at Bharat Mandapam in New Delhi. It is India's largest mobility expo. Addressing the gathering, the Prime Minister thanked the people for electing his government for the third consecutive time. He said that the scope of this year's expo has become much bigger as the event is also being held at two other locations in the National Capital Region. Last year, the event had over 800 exhibitors and over 1.5 lakh people attended the event.

Novak Djokovic surpassed Roger Federer to set the record for playing the most Grand Slam matches in tennis history. The Serbian tennis legend played his 430th match by defeating Portuguese qualifier Jaime Faria in the second round of the Australian Open.
