Former Army Chief VK Singh took oath as the new Governor of Mizoram. Singh is the 25th Governor of the state since Mizoram got full statehood in 1987. Former Union Minister Singh will replace Hari Babu Kambhampati, who has been appointed as the Governor of Odisha.

The International Monetary Fund (IMF) has revised India's economic growth forecast for FY25 down to 6.5% from earlier estimates. Despite this reduction, the IMF has maintained a stable growth outlook for FY26. This adjustment reflects current challenges, including global economic uncertainties and domestic inflationary pressures, which could impact India's growth path. The revision comes in the context of the country's ongoing post-pandemic recovery, with the IMF citing inflation, investment slowdown and geopolitical risks as key factors that could impact economic momentum.

4. A

In a significant move to boost the fintech sector, the Electronics and IT Department of the Government of Odisha has partnered with Singapore's Global Finance and Technology Network (GFTN) to set up a Global Competence Centre in Bhubaneswar. The collaboration aims to promote innovation in insurtech and related sectors, in line with India's vision of "Insurance for All" by 2047.

A man opened fire in Iran's Supreme Court in Tehran. 2 judges were killed in this attack. Meanwhile, Supreme Court spokesperson Asghar Jahangir has claimed that the judges were killed by entering their room. Both judges were hearing cases of national security, terrorism and espionage. After firing at both, the attacker committed suicide. Another judge was also injured in this entire incident. Apart from this, a bodyguard has also been injured.

The Government of India has reconstituted the Executive Council of the Prime Minister's Museum and Library Society and appointed Nripendra Misra as the Chairman of the Executive Council of the Society. The Executive Council is the highest decision making body of the Prime Minister's Museum and Library Society. The Prime Minister's Museum and Library Society was established by the Government of India on 1 April 1966 to manage the Nehru Memorial Museum and Library, now known as the Prime Minister's Museum and Library.

8. B

Randhir Jaiswal, official spokesperson of the Ministry of External Affairs (MEA), announced that India and the US have agreed to enhance cooperation and information sharing on cyber threat intelligence and digital forensics in criminal investigations. In Washington DC, Indian Ambassador to the US Vinay Kwatra and Acting US Deputy Secretary (Homeland Security) Christie Canegallo signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) on cybercrime investigations.

9. B

Prime Minister Narendra Modi distributed over 65 lakh property cards to rural households in over 50,000 villages across 12 states and union territories under the Centre's SVAMITVA (Survey of Villages and Mapping with Improved Technology in Rural Areas) scheme. He asserted that rural digitisation is now "advancing rural empowerment by leveraging the power of technology and good governance".

The year 2025 marks the 60th anniversary of the establishment of diplomatic relations between India and Singapore. To commemorate this special occasion, Hon'ble President Smt. External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar said he has urged the US to set up a US consulate in Bengaluru and promised to open an Indian diplomatic mission in Los Angeles. Mr Jaishankar was in Bengaluru to attend the "site dedication ceremony" of the fifth US Consulate in India, which will start functioning in Bengaluru soon.

India's startup ecosystem has grown rapidly over the past two decades and has become the third largest startup ecosystem in the world with over 100 unicorns. Key factors such as an increase in venture capital, a digitally savvy population, and an innovation culture have fueled growth in cities such as Bengaluru and Delhi-NCR. Government initiatives and impressive funding trends are expected to lead to continued expansion and more unicorns by 2030.

13. C

The Union Cabinet has approved setting up of a third launchpad at the Satish Dhawan Space Centre (SDSC) at Sriharikota in Andhra Pradesh to support future use of ISRO's heavier Next Generation Launch Vehicles (NGLVs). SDSC, India's only space centre, became operational in 1971 with the launch of a 'Rohini-125' rocket and was renamed in 2002 in honour of former ISRO chairman Satish Dhawan.

Shri Ashok Chandra took over as Managing Director and Chief Executive Officer of Punjab National Bank. He has a wide and varied experience of over 33 years in the banking industry. The Ministry of Plantations and Community Infrastructure has signed an agreement with India to set up 60 smart classrooms in selected plantation schools. As per the MoU, the Government of India will provide grant assistance of Rs 500 million. The MoU was signed and exchanged by Indian High Commissioner Santosh Jha and Secretary of the Ministry of Plantations and Community Infrastructure BK Prabhat Chandrakirti.
